19-20/63 Representatives reports:

Police: A reminder to all residents to make sure that doors are kept locked now that we have dark nights. This is the time when burglaries are most likely to be carried out.

Youth Club: D Thorne reported that the youth club is operating smoothly with no problems. There will be the unveiling of the stone cairn at the entrance to the village at Whitecross on Saturday, 12 October 2019 at 3:00pm. Everyone is welcome. The work has been carried out by some of the youth club members under the supervision of Mark Powers.

Parish paths: Mrs Ellerington-Jennings has been asked by some of the ramblers as to whether the grass on the canal path is to be cut again. The clerk is to seek guidance from East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

Leven playing fields association: K Macklin and M Hilton reported that the 'Bikers weekend' held at the sports hall recently was a great success. Some complaints had been received and lessons have been learnt and changes will be made if the event is held again next year.

19-20/64 General purpose matters:

Motorbikes – Leven bypass: Mrs Ellerington-Jennings had raised the problem of speeding bikers on the bypass with the police especially on Thursday and Sunday evenings.

Leven tractor run: Mrs Ellerington-Jennings reported on the Leven tractor run that took place on Sunday, 22 September. 83 tractors took part in the run and raised £4250 to be shared between 3 charities.

Leven school governor vacancy: Mrs Ellerington-Jennings has been appointed community governor.

17/19 East Street: Complaints have been received regarding the state of the overgrown hedge. It is not acceptable for residents to have to go onto the road to get by. M Hilton declared an interest in the matter. The clerk is to speak to M Hilton direct.

Nursery Walk frontage: A complaint has been received regarding the overgrown planting on the frontage of Nursery Walk on South Street. This has been brought to the attention of the landowner by the clerk and work is to be carried out. Mrs Ablett declared an interest.

75th Anniversary VE Celebrations 2020: Leven Festival committee are to acknowledge the 75th Anniversary celebrations at the Leven Festival in July 2020. However, this does not stop anyone in the village organizing celebrations for the weekend 8th – 10th May 2020.
