Welcome to the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme

There's lots of funded activities available for children and young people aged 5-16 years who attend an East Riding school in the summer holidays. Why not burn off some energy on our sports, dance, and football camps, or relax at our farm and craft experiences? You could also learn a new skill by taking part in outdoor adventure, cooking or music workshops. Plus, there's programmes just for our young people and SEND specific sessions too.

All HAF sessions are available for children and young people in receipt of benefits related free school meals who attend an East Riding school, and we also have a small number of places on all programmes for pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan. Your child can attend up to 16 sessions for free during the summer holidays with a meal provided at each event.



If your child doesn't qualify for a free place, some of our providers offer payable options in the holidays too. Also check out the website below to see what's happening in your area.

All About HAF

How do I know if my child is eligible for free HAF activities?

Give us a call on (C) (01482) 394799. All you'll need is your National Insurance number or registered asylum seekers number, and we will be able to check to see if your child is able to attend sessions during the holidays.

My children are in Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 and receive free school meals, can they book onto HAF?

Although all pupils receive universal free meals in foundation and primary education, HAF is only for those families in receipt of various benefits, including universal credit (with an income no more than \pounds 7,400) income support, etc. HAF is funded by the Department for Education who recognises that there are greater pressures for those families during the school holidays.

Do I have to book all 16 sessions with the same provider?

No, your child may wish to attend the same provision (it might be close to where you live or they may enjoy a particular activity), but you can choose from all our programmes.

My child has special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), can they attend HAF sessions?

Please ring the provider before making a booking to ensure they can cater for the needs of your child and will be able to make reasonable adjustments. If your child requires 1:1 support, please email at (a) haf@eastriding.gov.uk two weeks before the session is due to take place. Additional support will be allocated on a case-by-case basis. Barnardo's Bumble B's clubs are not a HAF provider but will be running in the school holiday so check out their webpage at (c) dsi.barnardos.org.uk/bumble-bs and search for activities on the Local Offer website too at (c) eastridinglocaloffer.org.uk



Will my child receive a free meal at each session?

Yes, all providers strive to offer a hot meal, but cold options may be available instead. Please speak to the provider about meal choices and inform of any allergies or intolerances.

How do I get to the session if I don't have a car?

Local bus companies are offering single bus journeys for a maximum cost of £2 until 31 December 2024. Visit gov.uk/guidance/2-bus-fare-cap#yorkshire-and-the-humber for more information.

What will my children need to bring with them?

Please bring a drink and wear suitable shoes. Your provider will tell you if there is anything specific they need to bring. Wearing sunscreen and rain jacket might be good options too!

What happens if my child is sick on the day or we are unable to attend?

Contact the provider ASAP to let them know your child is unable to attend. Please note that if you continue to miss sessions, providers have to right to cancel future bookings. We want as many children to enjoy HAF as possible and some providers have waiting lists.

It's Useful to Know

FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

East Riding of Yorkshire Council will continue to support pupils living in the East Riding who are eligible for Free School Meals during the summer holidays and the October half-term holiday. If your child attends an East Riding school, then your school will arrange Free School Meal vouchers for you.

If you live in the East Riding but your child attends a school outside of the East Riding and is eligible for free school meals please contact contact schoolorganisation@eastriding.gov.uk to claim your vouchers.

CHILDCARE VOUCHERS

You can claim back 85 per cent of childcare costs if eligible for universal credit. To find out more visit **o** gov.uk/universal-credit/how-to-claim. Vouchers are available to those on low income, out of work or if you are unable to work and have £16,000 or less in savings.
